## Message from our Artistic Director & Director of Business Operations

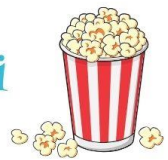

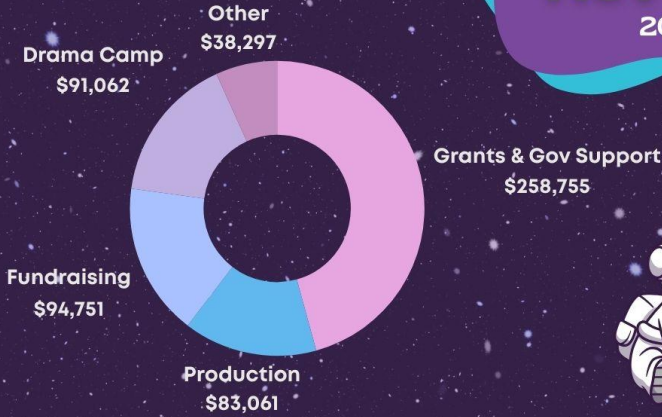

2022 - 2023



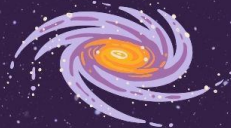
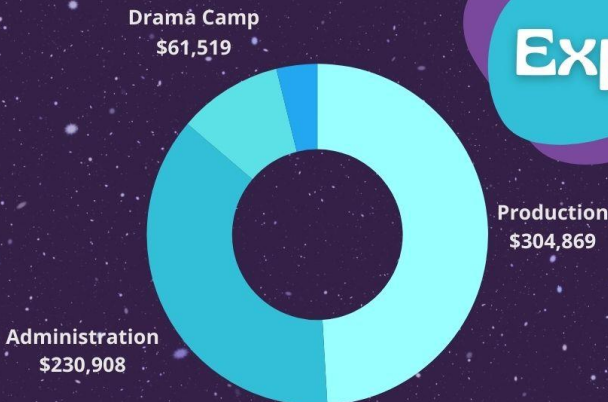
**Total Revenue \$565,926**

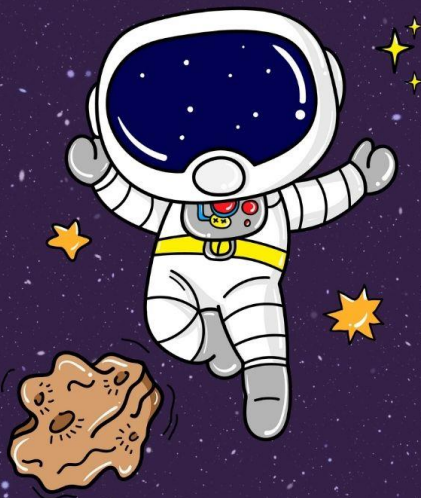
