“You can go back to being your mom’s daughter again.” When I heard those supportive words from Bethany’s social worker, I felt an immediate sense of comfort and relief. Those words meant a lot to me at the time, and they still do.

My mom had Alzheimer’s disease, and it caused challenging behavioural issues that we all struggled with for some time. It was incredibly difficult for my mom...and for us. When mom moved to Bethany Riverview in Calgary, I was surprised and impressed with all the healthcare professionals involved in her care plan. The staff had the expertise and strategies to deal with dementia and the issues surrounding the disease. And the care was holistic - not just physical. They found solutions that worked best for each person. Eventually, my mom settled in, and her behaviours improved.

I could see that the employees cared for, loved, and enjoyed spending time with the residents, including my mom. This made me trust them. They connected with her, and she would respond back to them non-verbally. An enormous weight was lifted from my shoulders, and it was a big deal to no longer feel worried, knowing she was well-taken care of when I wasn’t there. I cannot thank donors like you enough for your ongoing support of the Bethany Care Foundation. Your kindness provides seniors and adults with disabilities who make their home at Bethany with the care-enhancing programs they deserve. Without you, residents would not enjoy the enriching music, recreation, and emotional therapy programs that allow families to experience moments of reconnection and joy with their loved ones.
