

# A MESSAGE FROM FOUNDER & CEO SHARON HAPTON



Every day across this country, families are being forced to make impossible choices between food and bills. The need has never been greater. In 2025, nearly 10 million Canadians, including almost 3 million children, faced food insecurity. This past year, the affordability crisis deepened, stretching household budgets and community supports to the breaking point.

But in the midst of this hardship, something beautiful happened. Because of the generosity of the Soup Sisters & Broth Brothers community, Canadians in crisis received more than just a meal. They received comfort, dignity, and hope. Together, we helped social service agencies across the country, supported families in crisis, and nourished Alberta students.

Like so many of the families and charities we serve, we've also been impacted by rising costs. For the first time in our history, we've made a small increase to the price of our soups. Even so, we're proud to say that every serving remains wholesome, nourishing, and far more affordable than canned or processed alternatives.

This past year has also brought new opportunities for partnership and growth. We've collaborated with organizations that share our belief that good food is a human right, and more agencies than ever are now serving Hugs in a Bowl to their clients. As a Good Food Organization with Right to Food, we're part of a national network working to make quality nourishment accessible to all. To build stability for the future, we also launched a new social enterprise that allows us to generate income and sustain our mission beyond grant funding: Hug in a Bowl Enterprises.

There's been so much discussion over the years about what needs to change in our social safety net. At Soup Sisters, we've always believed that change begins with connection - the exchange - one bowl at a time. When someone who is reeling from a crisis receives a warm bowl of soup, it sends a simple but powerful message: you matter, and you are not alone.

We may not be able to fix everything, but we can fill a bowl, lift a spirit, and remind someone that care still exists in this world. And that, I believe, makes all the difference.





#### **SOUP BANK**

64,000

Soup Bank servings to 66 Canadian charities We are driven by the idea that everything starts with proper nourishment and believe we can fuel bodies and minds with quality food - in an affordable way. That is why we created Canada's only Soup Bank, a social enterprise model delivering quality soup meals nationwide.

Our focus is to help Canadian charities looking for a way to reduce food costs and staff time while still providing quality and nutritious food to their clients. The frontline agency only pays for the soup at cost, just as they would purchase food from a retailer but without inflated pricing, profit margins, or transportation fees. Our soup meals frees up staff and volunteer time so that resources are allocated to the critical needs of clients.



# SOUP-MAKING EVENTS

Something magical happens when people gather in the camaraderie of the kitchen to make delicious soup for others. Together with our culinary partners, volunteers experience a deep sense of fulfillment through giving nutritious Hugs in a Bowl to local agencies and emergency shelters.

This mainstay of our organization is a popular community investment activity for corporate team-building events. The original feel-good Soup Sisters event raises awareness of food insecurity and the local recipient organization, all while making, sharing and donating Hugs in a Bowl.



#### **SOUPER KIDS**

20,000 Souper Kids servings



In schools across Canada, teachers and administrators see firsthand the toll hunger takes on students—poor concentration, lack of energy, and the psychological stress of not knowing when the next meal will come. There is a desire to provide nutritious food, but the resources are often unavailable.

We believe that no child should feel singled out for their financial situation. Food is a fundamental human right, and all students deserve access to nourishing meals. We take a whole-school approach by feeding the entire student body; there's no separation between who has and who has not. Every child enjoys the same hot, nutritious meal together.


